Lake Report - January 2019

Rain, rain and more rain! Our lake is at full pool and we have had extreme levels of rising water. My estimates are of about two feet high judging from debris in my yard. I found large pieces of wood, complete with attached hardware (galvanized lag bolts) floating in the lake and thoughts of damaged docks and bulkheads came to mind. Check yours out as these may have come from your property.

Having heard of recent beaver damage, I have contacted the trappers, but have no word of any results. These pesky critters are here on a regular basis. I see them occasionally on my end of the lake, so be sure to protect your precious trees and plants.

For those that have given it a try, the fishing has been erratic despite the cold, fresh water. A few mature resident tilapias have succumbed to the cold and were found by kayak fishermen. I would love hearing from anyone wanting to report their fishing results. Also, give me a call if you have any beaver damage.
